Subject: Orientation Programme on SAGY.

Madam,

I am directed to furnish herewith reports on Orientation and Awareness Programmes on SAGY in the respective Gram Sabhas as follows along with photographs :-

1. **Nongbah Myrdon (Ri-Bhoi District)** – The Orientation Programme was held on 11th December, 2014 and attended by the Officials from the C & RD Department, Govt. of Meghalaya, District administration, Line Departments concerned, Charge Officer, Local Headman and Headmen of neighbouring villages and the villagers of Nongbah Myrdon.
The objectives and the process of implementation of SAGY were highlighted by the various speakers. The villagers were informed that their villages should become a model village which will motivate and inspire the neighbouring villages to learn and adapt. The Awareness Generation, Environment creation and Social Mobilisation for SAGY has been successfully achieved by the Orientation Programme.
2. **Shangpung village (West Jaintia Hills District)** - The Orientation Programme was held on 15th December, 2014 in the presence of Local MLA, i/c Deputy Commissioner, West Jaintia Hills District, Project Director, DRDA, West Jaintia Hills District, Master Trainer, Charge Officer, Line Departments concerned, Local Gram Sabha functionaries and its adjoining villages and the Local residents. An Awareness Generation and Environment creation and Mobilisation for SAGY was accordingly delivered in the programme by various speakers. Concept of approaches like converging of resources to be effectively managed in the village and the local resident assured their co-operation and active involvement in the SAGY as per timeline. There was interaction with the Gram Sabha and the youth after the programme. Interestingly, Womenfolk dominated the attendance and also interaction with them by the Officers of the Line Departments concerned and the Charge Officer was witnessed. 3. **Dingak Watso Aja (North Garo Hills District)** – An awareness programme on SAGY was held in Achugre village on the 16th December, 2014 and details are attached
